Membership has reached a plateau phase and to increase it we have to look to attracting more local and overseas Associate members.

Our attempt to secure recognition of the specialty by the College of Surgeons is progressing at a glacial pace. However, we remain optimistic about this and continue to look for different angles including cultivating close affiliation and collaboration with international colorectal surgical societies especially those in ASEAN. A Travelling Fellowship has been proposed and the details including funding will be worked out in the coming year.
